Judging Criteria

1. Conditions of Entry must be satisfied.
2. Selection will be made across the following categories:
 - Years 3-4 5-6
 - Years 7-9

Entries will be chosen from each of the above categories. Three entries from each category will be chosen as 1st 2nd 3rd places; encouragement prizes and awards will be given to other worthy entries in each category.

- 3 Selection will be based on the artistic and creative merit of the artwork.

The successful artwork:

- Is relevant to the theme of space.
- Expresses an idea that is immediately apparent.
- Is designed with imagination.
- Has good visual appeal because of bold colour and good layout.
- Has a written explanation that clearly describes the artwork, and is legible.

Conditions of Entry

1. Each entry will comprise:

ENTRY FORM - A completed entry form including 50 words or less describing the meaning of the artwork and attached to the front of the artwork.

ARTWORK - An original piece of artwork on lithograph or cartridge paper.
- Must be two –dimensional and no more than 2mm thick.
- Size A4 (21cm x 30cm)

2. Adult assistance must be limited to guidance for ideas and ensuring student safety. Adults are not permitted to assist students.

3. Participants must be school students currently enrolled in years 3-9 in any primary or secondary school or studying an approved equivalent home study course.

4. To enter your artwork into the Galactic Circle Space Club you must be a member.

5. On receipt, all entries will become and remain the property of Young Astronauts Space Schools Australia. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry. No responsibility is accepted for entries not received by YASSA.

6. All Entries must be received by YASSA on or before 5.00pm December 10 2010.

7. Winners will announced at the Australian Space School January 22nd 2011 and will be listed on the YASSA website.
